## ECOWILL – The Project

**ECO**driving **W**idespread **I**mplementation for **L**earner Drivers and **L**icensed Drivers

**ECOWILL** aims to increase the number of Ecodriving training programmes in Europe. The project focuses on implementing short duration training sessions (of one hour) and e-learning solutions for drivers of passenger cars and van/light commercial vehicles (LCV)  $\leq 3.5t$  GVM\*. Between May 2010 and April 2013, ECOWILL intends to conduct Ecodriving training programmes for licensed drivers in 13 European countries (Austria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, Poland, Spain, the Netherlands and United Kingdom).
